- 6. I will attend all appropriate meetings and other appointments, and ensure apologies are logged when absent.
- 7. I will participate in collective decision making, accept a majority decision, and not act individually unless specifically authorised to do so.
- 8. I will not make public comments on behalf of the Forum unless authorised to do so.
- 9. I understand that substantial breach in any part of this code may result in procedures being put in motion that may result in my being asked to resign from the group.
- 10. Should this happen, I understand that I have the right to appeal this decision in writing to the Chair or Vice Chair. In the event that I am asked to resign, I will accept the majority decision of the group and resign at the earliest opportunity.
